## **Job Summary**

Responsible for performing maintenance, repairs, inspections, and alterations of company and outside customer operated aircraft and articles as assigned in accordance with Air Associates' policies and procedures. Ensures company operational goals and objectives are met, while guaranteeing all aircraft maintenance documentation is executed in compliance with applicable Federal Aviation Regulations, company policies and procedures, and applicable maintenance manuals.

## **Essential Functions and Responsibilities include the following**

- Perform scheduled and unscheduled or special inspection in compliance with regulatory authorities and industry standards.
- Troubleshoot and perform maintenance and repairs on aircraft and engines and various electrical, mechanical and hydraulic components and accessories.
- Make required work order entries and return to service log entries for aircraft and engines and propellers.
- Perform aircraft, engine run-ups and taxi, to test system performance. Participate in maintenance test flights
- Service oil, fuel and hydraulic systems. Provide nitrogen oxygen and battery servicing
- Understand the operation of various airframe and power plant systems.
- Assist other technicians in the repair of systems and perform other duties as assigned.
- Repositioning and towing of aircraft.
- Communicating with customers and other company departments personnel.
- Ensures all aircraft maintenance documentation is executed in compliance with applicable Federal Aviation Regulations, company policies and procedures, and applicable maintenance manuals to include specific chapters
- Maintains work area in a clean and professional manner
- Other Duties as assigned
