Air Associates of Kansas Rental Aircraft Qualification Policy

- 1. In order to rent AAK aircraft, pilots must demonstrate *proficiency* in both the airframe and installed avionics while be used in the particular flight conditions (VFR or IFR).
- 2. <u>Airframe proficiency</u> must be demonstrated in the airframe on an annual basis with an Air Associates CFI. Minimum airframe checkout requirements include a written test, systems operation, flight planning, stalls, emergencies and at least 3 takeoffs and landings.
 - C-172 checkout applies to all C172 variants except the G1000 and the G600 variant
 - C-182 checkout also applies to the G1000 C172
 - C-182 and C-350 checkouts all require a High-Performance Endorsement and are unique to each airframe
 - C-350 checkout requires 500 hours total time with 15 hrs. in model with a current IPC or 5 hrs. of flight training and 5 hrs. of ground training in the C350
- 3. <u>Avionics proficiency</u> must be demonstrated at least once to an Air Associates CFI.
 - Avionics checkout can be accomplished simultaneously with the airframe checkout
 - An IFR (Round-dial or G1000) avionics checkout also applies to VFR operation
 - Round-dial or G1000 avionics checkout may be demonstrated in the AATD
 - o VFR G600 checkout may be accomplished via a ground-powered aircraft
 - o IFR G600 checkout must be accomplished in flight
- 4. Exceptions to this policy may only be granted in advance by the owner of Air Associates or his designee.
